Chapter: Surah Yaseen

A brief description of Surah Yaseen

Surah Yaseen is a Makki Surah with 83 Verses and it is the 36th chapter in Qur'an. It can be divided into 5 sections.

First section focused on the truthfulness in the message of Prophet Muhammed [PBUH] and second strengthens it by discussing the story of three messengers and their people. A man who advised those people to follow the straight path was killed by them and Allah honored him with Jannah. Following verses are giving us an insight about the wonderful creations and an opportunity to find out the powerful Creator behind it. Then discuss about the Resurrection and attitude of disbelievers.

Explanation of ayaat

1. "By the Qur'an, full of wisdom"

This Qur'an is perfect which carries the wise words. There is no chance for any mistake or falsehood.

2. "To warn the people whose forefathers were not warned".

This Ayah clarifies that to the Arabs no warner (messenger) was sent for long time. After a long gap, when Prophet Muhammed [PBUH] came to them with clear message they were not ready to accept it.

3. "The word has been proved true against the greater part of them, they will not believe".

This refers the attitude of disbelievers and due to that the punishment has become inevitable for most of them. As Allah's knowledge is limitless, He preserved in a clear record(the Mother of Books-Al-LawhulMahfoodh) that they will not believe.

The verses 'We have put yokes around their neck....." and "We have put a barrier before"

Also indicates their arrogance and rebelliousness.

4. "And our duty is only to convey the message to you clearly"

The messengers sent to people of town said this to their people as a reply for their disapproval of a human messenger. The reason the people said to reject them was 'you are only men like us'.

This Ayah commonly focuses on the duty of a messenger that they appointed only to convey the message of Allah to people not to force them to believe.

5. "And why should I not worship Him Who has created me".

These are the words said by the man from farthest city. In his opinion, as Allah is the Creator of human, He deserved the worship and associating any partner with him is the greatest sin.

6. "It was said: Enter Paradise"

When the man advised the people to obey and follow the messengers, they threatened and killed him. As he was killed, Allah honored him by giving him an entry into the Paradise. Once he received such an opportunity, he is having a wish that 'if the people came to know about the favors he received from Allah' (they will understand the value of following the message and leading a righteous life).

The main lesson we have to learn from this is 'To follow the guidelines of Allah and His messengers and convey the message of truth (Islam) into others in possible ways.

*Prophet Muhammed [PBUH] said: "The best Jihad is to speak the truth in front of a tyrant".

Prophet Muhammed [PBUH] said: 'When man dies, all his deeds come to an end except three: an ongoing charity which he leaves behind, knowledge which is beneficial to others and a righteous child who prays for him".(Reported by Muslim)
